The Office of the Vice Chancellor for Research and Creative Activities in collaboration with various stakeholders have developed **UCLA Policy 956: IP Revenue Sharing with Not-for-Profit Nongovernmental Organizations**. In accordance with <u>UCLA Policy 100:</u>

<u>Administrative Policies and Procedures</u>, this new policy has been placed on the <u>UCLA Administrative Policy website</u> for a 30-day public review and comment period. Please encourage faculty and staff in your departments to review this new policy and submit comments via the webpage by May 7, 2021.

UCLA Policy 956 addresses issues that should be considered before UCLA accepts revenue-sharing terms in a Research Support agreement and applies to UCLA researchers, Schools, Office of Contracts and Grants Administration (OCGA), and the Technology Development Group (TDG).
